

Using Maps.Me to navigate and add places to Openstreetmap in your community






Download Maps.Me from the [PlayStore](#) or App Store on your phone. Search for a place you know well and you will be prompted to download the surrounding area. It's worth doing this when you have good connectivity. You can then use it entirely off-line.

	<p>We'll use Mugumu, Tanzania as an example.</p> <p>Zoom in/out</p> <p>Click here to find your location</p> <p>Distance from current location to Mugumu</p>
<p>You can bookmark places that are important to you (these are only visible to you)</p>	
	<p>The + button is how you add places directly to Openstreetmap so that anyone in the world can see them online and through Maps.Me.</p> <p>You can also share your location (via What's app, email etc)</p>

Once you have selected the location of the place you want to add to the map, choose what category it is. **Keep in mind it's a limited list, so not every desired feature will be available using this ap.**




Note that you don't have to fill out every question.


Click on the tick/check mark.

When you add the first point, you will be prompted to create an openstreetmap account so that your map edits will be shared on openstreetmap. You only have to do this once.

If you don't have connectivity your points will be stored on your phone until you do. You can check if they have been uploaded by typing ?edits into the search box. If there are problems uploading open and close Maps.Me when you have connectivity.



This ap can also be used for navigation. Click on route to and type where you want to go.
